Reading Bags:

I hope your kids are loving reading their books each night. While listening to them read, please encourage them to look for sight words while reading. If they come to a words they do not know, encourage them to figure it out. They can look at the picture or use the sounds and blend them together to read the word.

Ask your child to tell you about what they just read. Start at the beginning and use details!



Language Arts

We are learning the different types of text. We will be reading picture books, nonfiction, poems and nursery rhymes.

We are learning how 2 letters work together to make a new sound (ng, th, sh, ch, ck). We are also working on opposites and word families.

We are learning new sight words each week. Please review the sight word cards that your child is bringing home each night. We are also reading books on our level and sight word books.

When writing with your child, please encourage them to use sight words. If they are not sure how to spell a word, help them say it slowly and write the sounds they here. Capital letters at the beginning, spaces and periods are very important.

Math

In class we are counting to 70, identifying, comparing and building shapes and using positional words.

We will exploring how numbers work together to make a larger number (adding) using stories, pictures and manipulatives.

Theme

We are learning about the weather and maps and models. The students are also working on coding. We are helping Goldilocks engineer and new chair for Baby Bear.
